South Gippsland Shire Council is seeking community feedback on the revised Council Plan and the proposed 16 new initiatives for 2018/19.

- Thursday 15 February at 41 Main Street, Foster from 1.00pm to 6.00pm
- Friday 16 February at 41 Main Street, Foster from 10.00am to 3.00pm.

An online OurSay forum will be open from 5 February to 18 February for community members to share ideas and support others. The forum will be available to access at www.oursay.org/southgippsland/council-priorities for anyone who can't make it along to one of the drop-in sessions or feels more comfortable conveying their ideas in writing.

South Gippsland Shire Mayor Councillor Lorraine Brunt encouraged the community to participate and share their thoughts.
