

# Administrators' Message



One of our past priority projects is in the process of being named, and we need you to help us. The community hub in Korumburra, referred to currently as the Korumburra Hub, is on the search for its name prior to the building commencement.

The name is very important and is needed for public safety. A unique name will make the space easily recognisable by emergency services and the general public and will be registered with Geographic Names Victoria so everyone can find it easily.

All community members are encouraged to submit a name that is related to Korumburra, it's people and culture, Traditional Owner heritage, local flora and fauna, Australian War contribution or something simple like the current temporary name.

Submitted names will be evaluated against the naming criteria and will then be shortlisted with the assistance of the Korumburra Round Table. Once the shortlist has been developed, the list will go out for public vote to decide on the name that will be officially adopted.
