

# South Gippsland Shire Council News Round One Community Grants

Applications for South Gippsland Shire Council's first round of 2024/25 Community Grants are now open until Saturday 31 August. The program offers grants of up to \$10,000 to help local not-for-profit community groups carry out important projects, planning, events, and even purchase much needed equipment.

Council awarded \$117,000 worth of funding to 20 successful applicants at last year's Round One Community Grants presentation night.
