HARD WASTE COLLECTION BOOKINGS

Bookings for the annual hard waste collection service are closing Friday 20 September.

This provides residents with a convenient way to dispose of hard rubbish, particularly if they are unable to attend a transfer station themselves.

All residents are eligible to receive one collection at a fee of \$157 per property. A reduced rate of \$56 This second round encourages new and more applies for pension card holders.
