The appointed contractor for the Mirboo North Pool repairs have set up on site. Council will share more information on the work to be completed in the next edition of the Mirboo North Times. As previously mentioned, the Pool will not be reopened in time for the start of the usual season, however it is hoped that the repairs will be completed in time to reopen later in the season.

### Baths Road Reserve Tracks Opening Soon

The Reserve is still closed at present, however we are making significant progress in relation to the re-opening of the Balook Street and Pool tracks and sections of Wildflower Track.
