Baths Road Reserve, Mirboo North

The Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Change (DEECA) and Forest Fire Management are on site at Baths Road Reserve to reduce the bushfire risk in the Reserve and create better access for firefighters. Surveys were conducted in Mirboo North to understand the balance between protection of community and the environment.

Residents near the work locations have been notified about the works, which will slow over the Christmas period to minimise disruption.

As has been the case with other works in the town, any material suitable for domestic firewood will be made available to the Mirboo North community.
