#### **Community Group Funding**

We believe that these funds will empower our community groups to thrive, supporting the retention of volunteers through various initiatives. Whether it's providing essential resources, organising

## **Community Training**

We also have a number of FREE community training sessions happening throughout May and June, starting with the Provide Basic Emergency Life Support (HLTAID010) course. In-person sessions will be held in Foster and Venus Bay, and participants will receive a nationally accredited statement of attainment upon completion.
