Council's Strategic Objective 3.3 states:

*Promote a safe and healthy community through our municipal public health programs, Emergency Management Plans and regulatory activities that meet our statutory obligations.*

By introducing this order, Council can enhance the protection of community, flora and fauna in the Shire.

**The introduction of a cat curfew will result in cat owners having to contain cats within their property boundaries for a specified time. It does not require owners to keep their cats contained within a cage or within their homes.**
